The Second Degree bachelors program is a twelve-month, intensive, full-time program for individuals holding bachelor's or master's degrees in other fields who want to become registered nurses (RNs). This accelerated program is designed to facilitate a career change for the more mature and experienced student. This program is offered face to face at the UH Sugar Land campus in Sugar Land, Texas, near Houston.

The primary focus of the Second Degree Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program is healthcare in diverse settings. The graduate will utilize scientific inquiry, evidence-based practice and nursing leadership concepts. The curriculum will provide graduates with strong critical thinking skills, leadership and management skills, and the ability to incorporate research findings and information from other disciplines into nursing practice. In addition, graduates will be ready to enter graduate degree programs with majors in administration, education, clinical nurse leadership, and advance practice nursing roles.

Admission to this program is every Spring. The deadline for application is August 15th.

Graduates of the Second Degree BSN program are eligible to apply to take the examination for licensure as registered nurses (NCLEX).

Applicants MUST submit a social security form PRIOR to the application deadline August 15th for application to be considered for admission to this program. The form may be obtained from the UH School of Nursing website under the Application Checklist information at <http://www.uh.edu/nursing/second-degree-bsn/checklist/>. UH School of Nursing requires a nursing entrance test. It is an admission requirement to submit TEAS V test scores. Applicants are allowed to submit up to 2 TEAS V test reports. This requirement is due by the deadline date of August 15th.

Provide supporting documentation for your application. You may update the information in this section after your submission.

The accepted file formats are MSWord (.doc, .docx), JPEG (.jpeg, .jpg), PNG (.png), Rich Text Format (.rtf), and ASCII Text file (.txt). The size limit for each file upload is 5MB.

The Dental Hygiene Baccalaureate Degree Completion Program is a flexible, online program for licensed dental hygienists who hold an associate degree from a CODA accredited dental hygiene program. Students will expand their knowledge of research and patient care and prepare for additional roles in dental hygiene education, research, public health, business or administration.

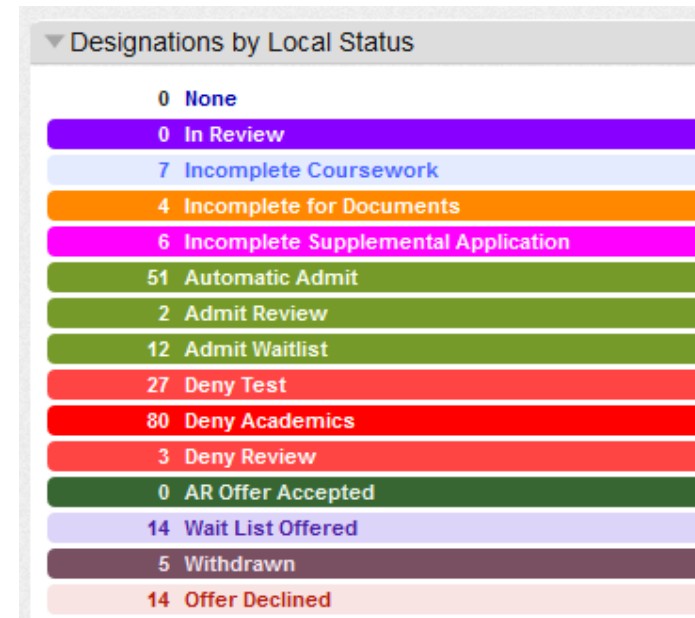
