About the Program

The Accelerated Entry Level MSN program is designed for individuals who possess a non-nursing bachelor's degree and are seeking to enter the nursing profession. The two year full-time program, including summers, prepares students to become eligible for the national RN licensing exam (NCLEX-RN) after completion of 1 ½ years of study and it culminates with a nursing applied research course or a master's thesis. Graduates will earn a BSN and the MSN degree. This School of Nursing/Extended Learning program is open to both California and other U.S. residents. The cost is \$675 per unit for the 97 unit program.

Eligibility Requirements

- Baccalaureate or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher learning
- GPA of 3.0 or above in the last 60 semester units earned.
- GRE Analytical Writing Score of 4 or above by the time of application
- Health-related work or volunteer experience
- Completed all prerequisite coursework with a C or higher by the time of application

Application Process

Admission to all SF State graduate and post graduate programs is a two-part process and two sets of transcripts are required.

 A Spring 2017 CSU Mentor application to the San Francisco State University Division of Graduate Studies must be submitted. The program of interest selection must be: "Nursing (Accelerated Entry Level)-MS"

- We strongly recommend completing the CSU Mentor application first (early in the application period) as applicants will need to
 provide the assigned SF State ID# on the School of Nursing supplemental application
- Complete details concerning this portion of the process are available on the SF State Division of Graduate Studies web site.







Map your Internal Process



The Direct Entry Master's (MSN) for Non-Nurses: Generalist Entry Master's (GEM) Clinical Nurse Leader (CNL) program at Rush University College of Nursing comprehensively prepares students, in a two-year full-time curriculum, to be a graduate (MSN) registered nurse (RN) clinician with a focus in clinical leadership. Graduates are prepared to function at a high level in inpatient, out-patient, and community settings. This program is for students who already have a bachelor's degree in an area other than nursing.

Upon receipt of your NursingCAS application, you will be asked to complete a brief Rush supplemental application. (Rush supplemental application fee is \$35.)

Applicants will be evaluated on the following:

- All calculated GPAs of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).
- 2. GRE scores are required unless waived under one of the following conditions: a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or greater; a pre-licensure nursing GPA of 3.0 or greater; or a graduate GPA (of a completed degree) of 3.5 or greater.*
- 3. Acceptable personal interview(s) with faculty.
- 4. Substantive personal essay statement
- 5. Three professional letters of recommendation from faculty and/or work managers (at least one letter must come from current or recent employer) are required. Relationship of recommenders to you must be in a supervisory capacity. Recommendations from friends, relatives, or co-workers will not be accepted and will cause your application to be delayed or denied.

Information for applicants with foreign education:

- 1. All foreign institutions attended require course-by-course ECE, WES, or CGFNS transcript evaluation.
- 2. The TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) is required for applicants who are non-native speakers of English. This requirement may be waived if the applicant has completed a minimum of three years of higher education AND received their baccalaureate degree in the United States.*
- ★ If required, GRE and TOEFL scores should be sent directly to Rush University. The school code for Rush is 3262.
