



BA/BS degree in nursing or BA/BS degree in a relevant field, from an accredited college or university.

Cumulative GPA of 2.8 on required transcripts.

Current, active RN license, within a state or territory of the United States.

Official transcripts to NursingCAS are required, coursework in NursingCAS is not required.





There is one application cycle per year from August to December with the start term of Summer (May) 2017. Application materials must be submitted to NursingCAS by our deadline of December 15, 2016 for admissions consideration. The application review process will start after the deadline of December 15; applicants will be notified of admissions decision in mid-February 2017.

#### Eligibility:

- · 4-year nursing degree from an accredited program conferred prior to the start of the program.
- . Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- . Current, unencumbered licensure as a registered nurse in the state in which clinicals will occur.
- . For new baccalaureate graduates, admission will be conditional pending licensure by the end of the summer semester.

In NursingCAS you will be required to choose your desired track and campus to attend. Applicants may apply for both St. Cloud and Duluth campuses but may only select one track for consideration. Applicants who designate more than one track (ex. FNP & PMHNP) will not be considered for admission.

The following requirements will be required in the online NursingCAS application. Please carefully review all the instructions or to beginning your application. No items should be sent directly to CSS.

#### A complete Nursing CAS application includes:

- 1. All official transcripts.
  - If you have previously attended CSS you must request your transcripts to be sent to Nursing CAS. Please contact <u>One Stop Student Services</u>.
  - 2. No high school transcripts are required.

#### 2. Essay uploaded

- The essay should represent your highest level of academic writing and demonstrate ability to participate in a rigorous, fast-paced academic program. Prepare a one page (maximum) essay, typed and double-spaced, using 12-point Times New Roman font and one-inch margins, answering the following:
  - How do you see the Advanced Practice Registered Nurse influencing your professional career and society?

Applicants pay a nominal fee to use the service; \$65 for 1 graduate application & \$35 for each additional graduate application and \$45 and \$30 for undergraduate programs.

  - 315 apps x 3.5 transcripts average = 1,102 transcripts
  - 315 apps x 3 recommendations average =945 letters/forms

  - Decisions letters are sent through
     NursingCAS to admitted applicants






### Results

Use the free tools in NursingCAS to manage your admissions and/or download and import the data and documents into existing systems.




