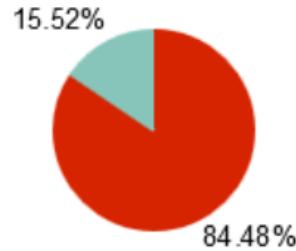

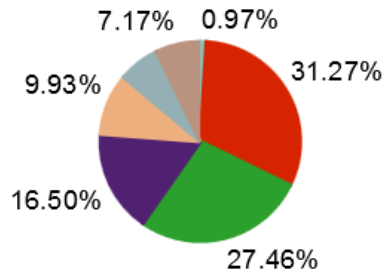

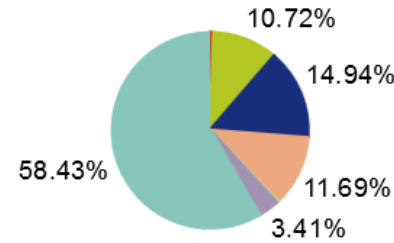

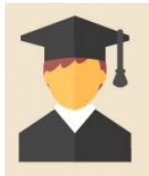

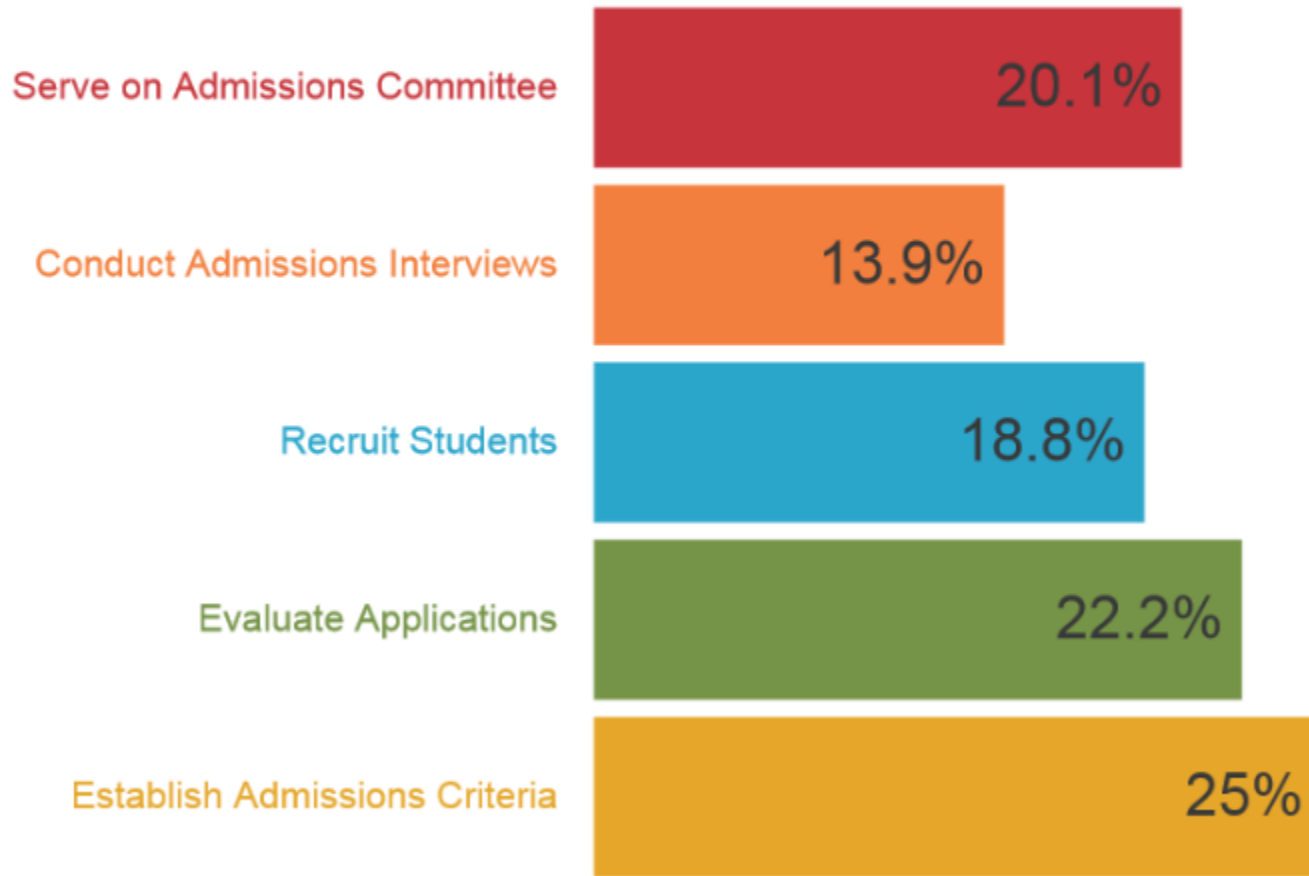

Early adopter in 2010, UH nursing administration and leadership were supportive of the concept. Needed to obtain buy-in from admissions and advising since they didn't want to change their processes to adapt to CAS.

Before NursingCAS

- Had to wait for the admissions office to release paper application files to the nursing school
- No data or reliable information on the number of applications in the pool prior to a deadline



After NursingCAS

- Nursing school has constant access to the applications electronically in WebAdMIT
- Can easily check, anywhere and any time, how many applicants are in the pipeline and communicate with them

Submit via NursingCAS. Upload a resume into the Document section of the NursingCAS application.
- Verification of Texas RN licensure - Upload licensure into the Documents section of the NursingCAS application. You may print from the Board of Nursing website.
- Input Professional work experience as defined by individual tracks into the NursingCAS application.
- Interview - Once NursingCAS application is reviewed. You will be contacted for an appointment for a personal interview.

Failure to complete any of these requirements by the specified deadlines will result in forfeiture of your class space to another applicant.

As you are aware, class space is limited. If for any reason you decide not to register for nursing courses at UH School of Nursing for fall 2016, please notify Dr. Kathleen Reeve (kdreeve@uh.edu). 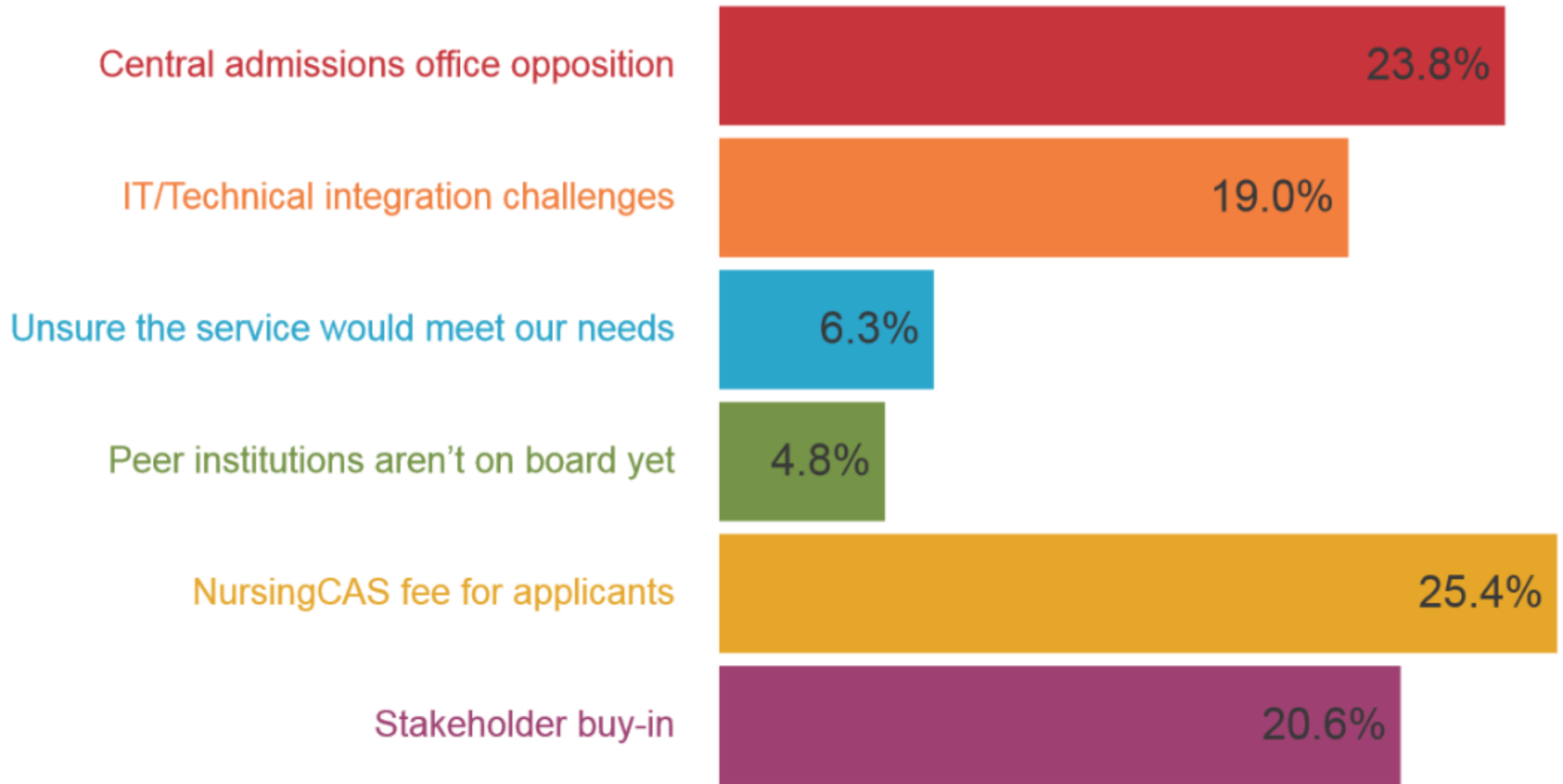

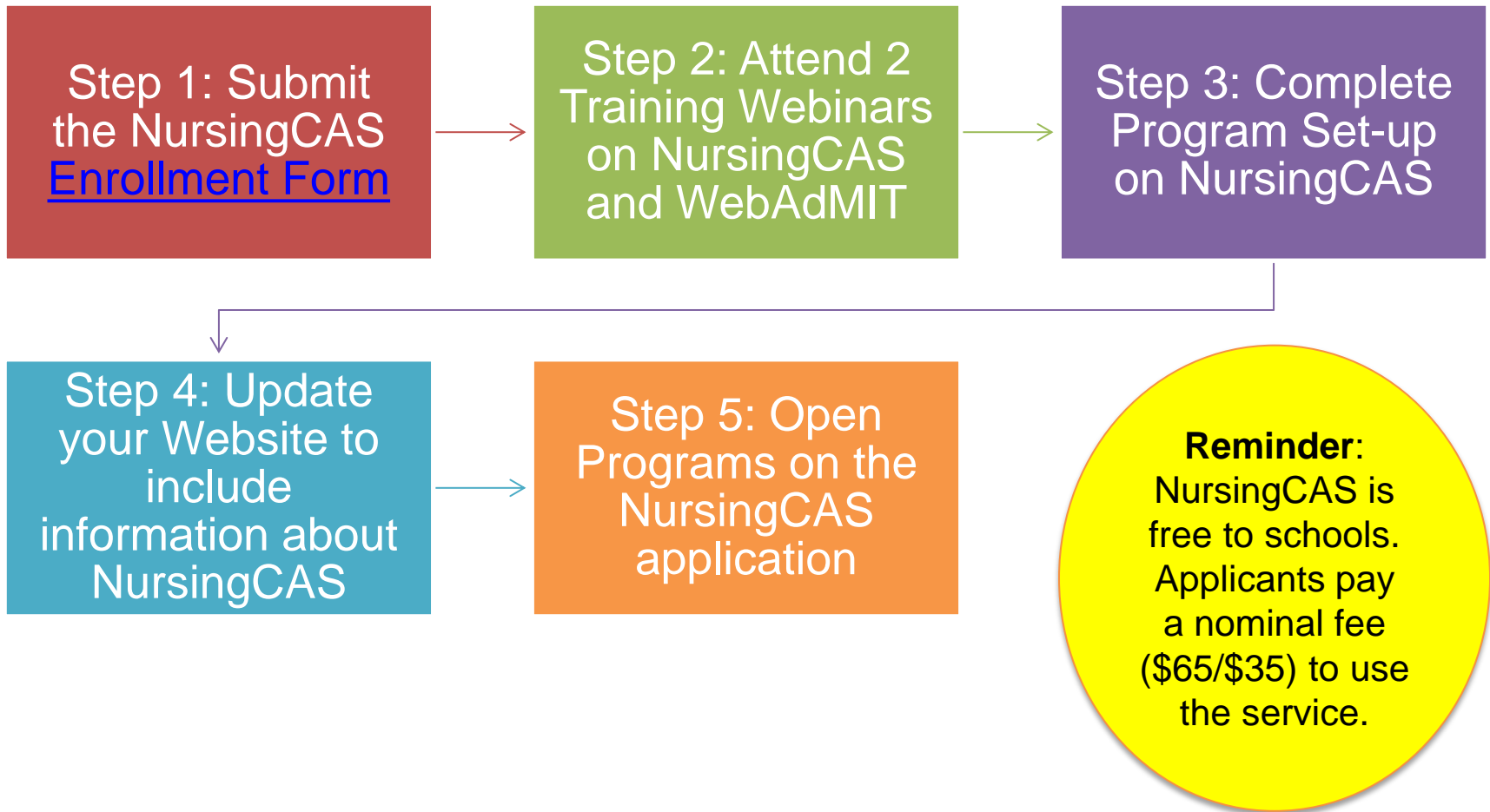

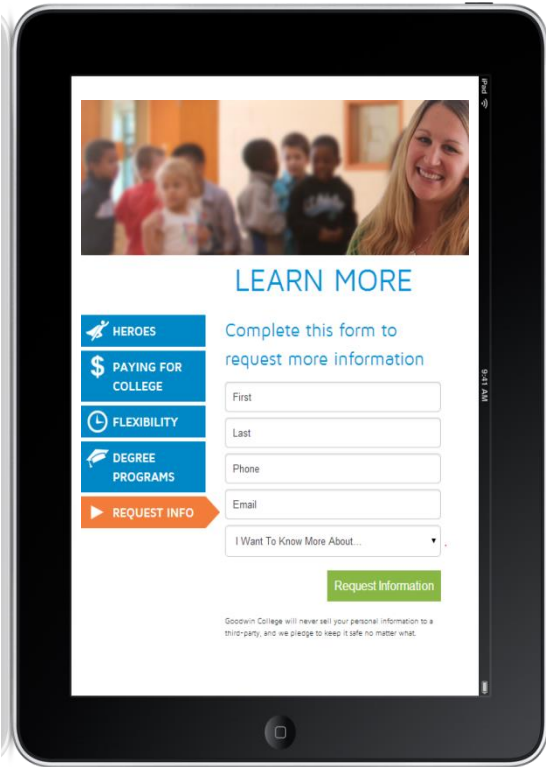
