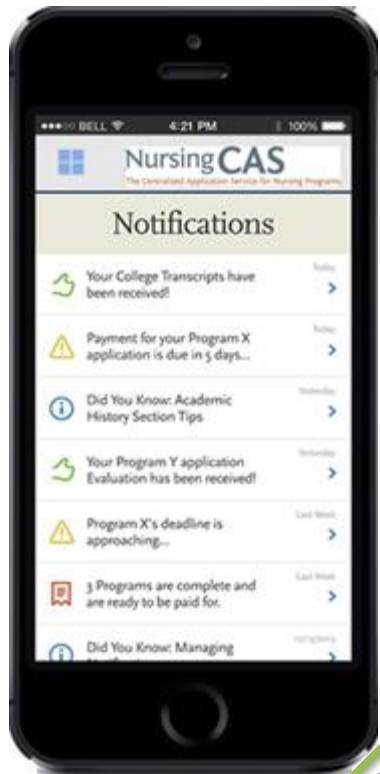

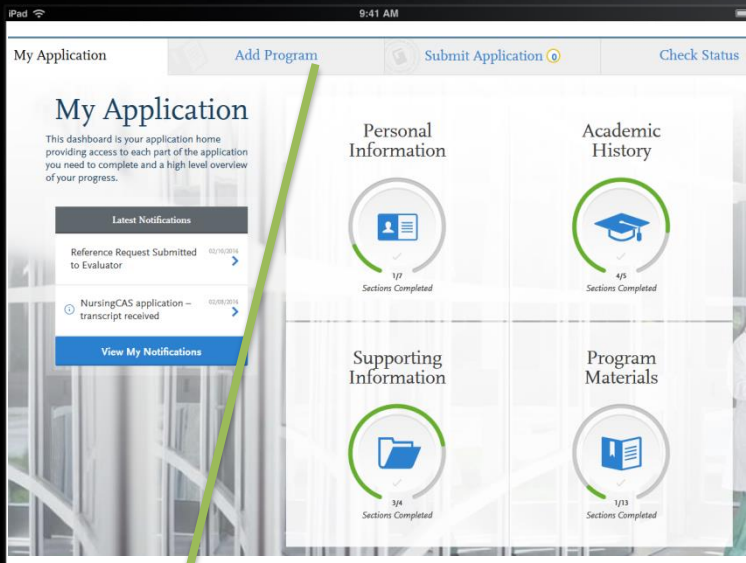

Navigating the Application



The Augusta University College of Nursing offers the first Adult Gerontology Acute Care Advanced Practice Nursing (APN) post graduate certificate program in the state of Georgia!

This concentration prepares nurses to provide advanced patient-family centered care in settings with acute and/or chronically ill patients across the adult lifespan.

This program educates advanced nurse clinicians for expert practice in leadership and clinical roles with a focus on care of adults and older adults that have acute and/or complete care needs in a variety of settings.

The post-graduate certification track in Adult Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner (AGACNP) is available for nurses who have their masters or doctoral degree, are certified as a nurse practitioner, and are desiring an additional certification as an AGACNP.

The program is approved by the Georgia Board of Regents as a web-based program with greater than 50 percent of the program taught online. Due to the progressive nature of the specialty courses, this option is typically considered part-time study only (less than 9 credit hours per semester.)

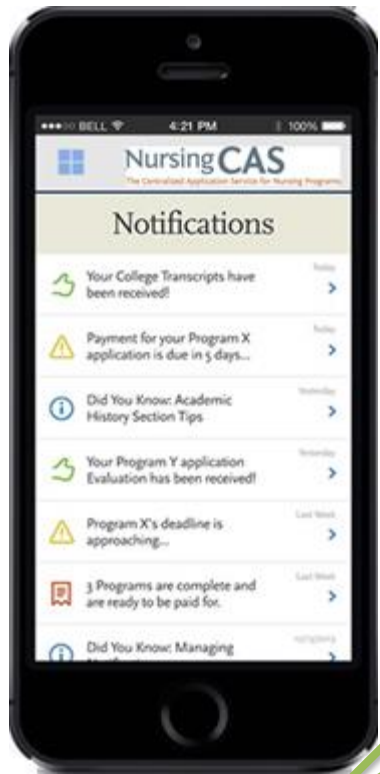

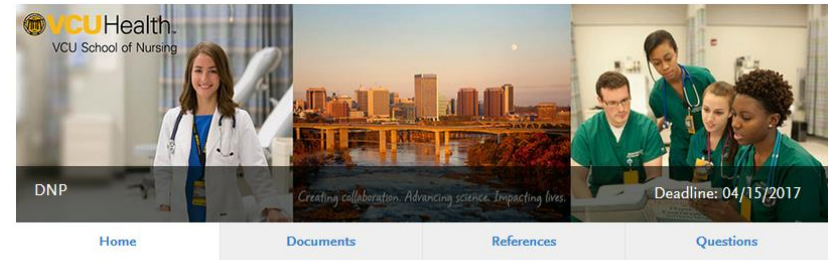

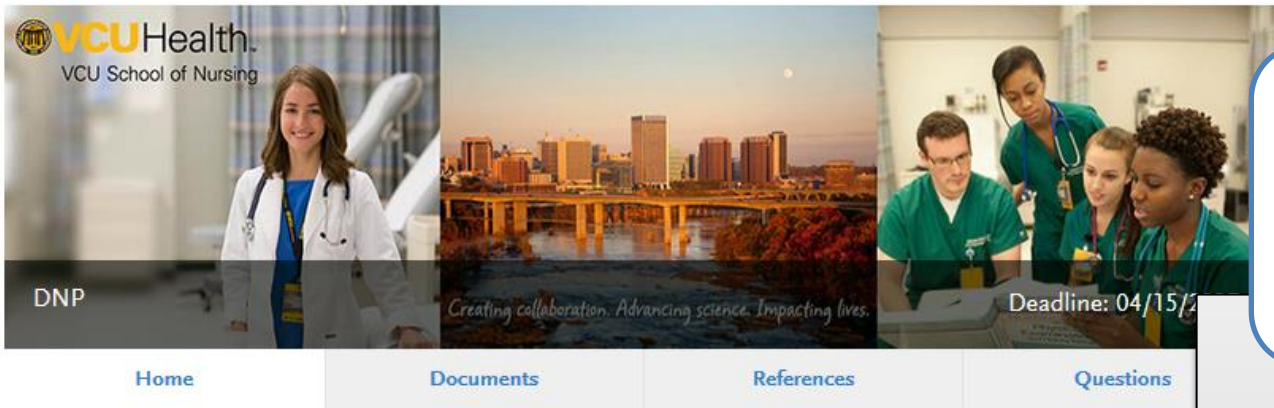

The VCU DNP program curriculum focuses on improving quality and safety outcomes in clinical practice. As part of this, the program emphasizes empowering advanced practice nurses who can act as leaders of change in healthcare. Your professional references should speak to your ability to succeed in achieving these goals and should not be from personal sources. Rather, you should invite individuals who can speak to your academic acumen and professional accomplishments. Ideally, you should invite individuals who are familiar with the roles of DNP prepared clinicians (e.g., other doctorally prepared nurses and clinicians). In general, an academic reference speaks to your prior academic performance (e.g., former academic advisor, faculty member) while a professional reference speaks to your professional skills (e.g., leader in your organization, supervisor).

A total of three (3) references are required.

Your references will receive an email message from NursingCAS that directs them to an online recommendation form. Notify your references in advance; they should receive a notification in their email inbox from NursingCAS. You should communicate to your references that occasionally, these notifications will default to “spam” or “junk” inboxes. If your references cannot find the email, you will need to contact NursingCAS to request that the notification be resent

Once you have saved an electronic reference, an email request will automatically be sent to the referer on your behalf. Please advise your referer to look for this email in their inbox, as well as their spam or junk-mail folder, as emails do occasionally get filtered out. Please note: All references submitted within this section of your application are program specific. If you choose to remove this program from your application, please understand your letters will be deleted along with the program.

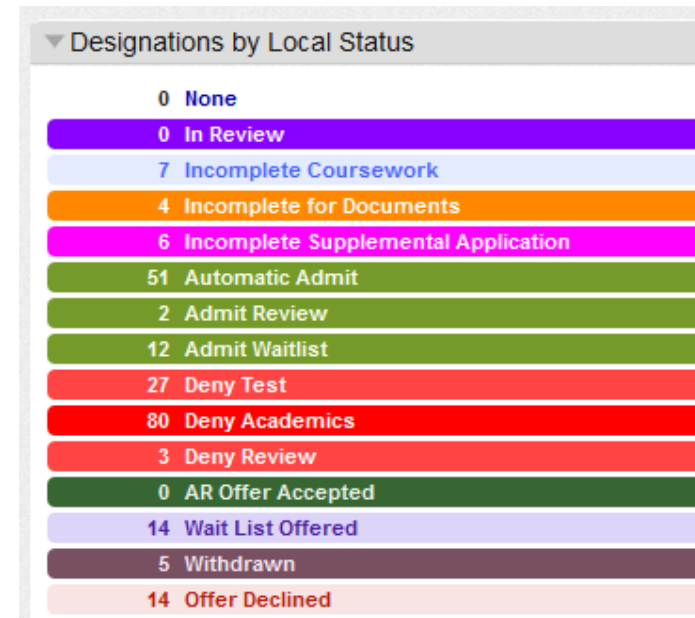

The Direct Entry Master's (MSN) for Non-Nurses: Generalist Entry Master's (GEM) Clinical Nurse Leader (CNL) program at Rush University College of Nursing comprehensively prepares students, in a two-year full-time curriculum, to be a graduate (MSN) registered nurse (RN) clinician with a focus in clinical leadership. Graduates are prepared to function at a high level in inpatient, out-patient, and community settings. This program is for students who already have a bachelor's degree in an area other than nursing.

Upon receipt of your NursingCAS application, you will be asked to complete a brief Rush supplemental application. (Rush supplemental application fee is \$35.)

Applicants will be evaluated on the following:

1. All calculated GPAs of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).
2. GRE scores are required unless waived under one of the following conditions: a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or greater; a pre-licensure nursing GPA of 3.0 or greater; or a graduate GPA (of a completed degree) of 3.5 or greater.*
3. Acceptable personal interview(s) with faculty.
4. Substantive personal essay statement
5. Three professional letters of recommendation from faculty and/or work managers (at least one letter must come from current or recent employer) are required. Relationship of recommenders to you must be in a supervisory capacity. Recommendations from friends, relatives, or co-workers will not be accepted and will cause your application to be delayed or denied.

Information for applicants with foreign education:

1. All foreign institutions attended require course-by-course ECE, WES, or CGFNS transcript evaluation.
2. The TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) is required for applicants who are non-native speakers of English. This requirement may be waived if the applicant has completed a minimum of three years of higher education AND received their baccalaureate degree in the United States.*

* If required, GRE and TOEFL scores should be sent directly to Rush University. The school code for Rush is 3262.

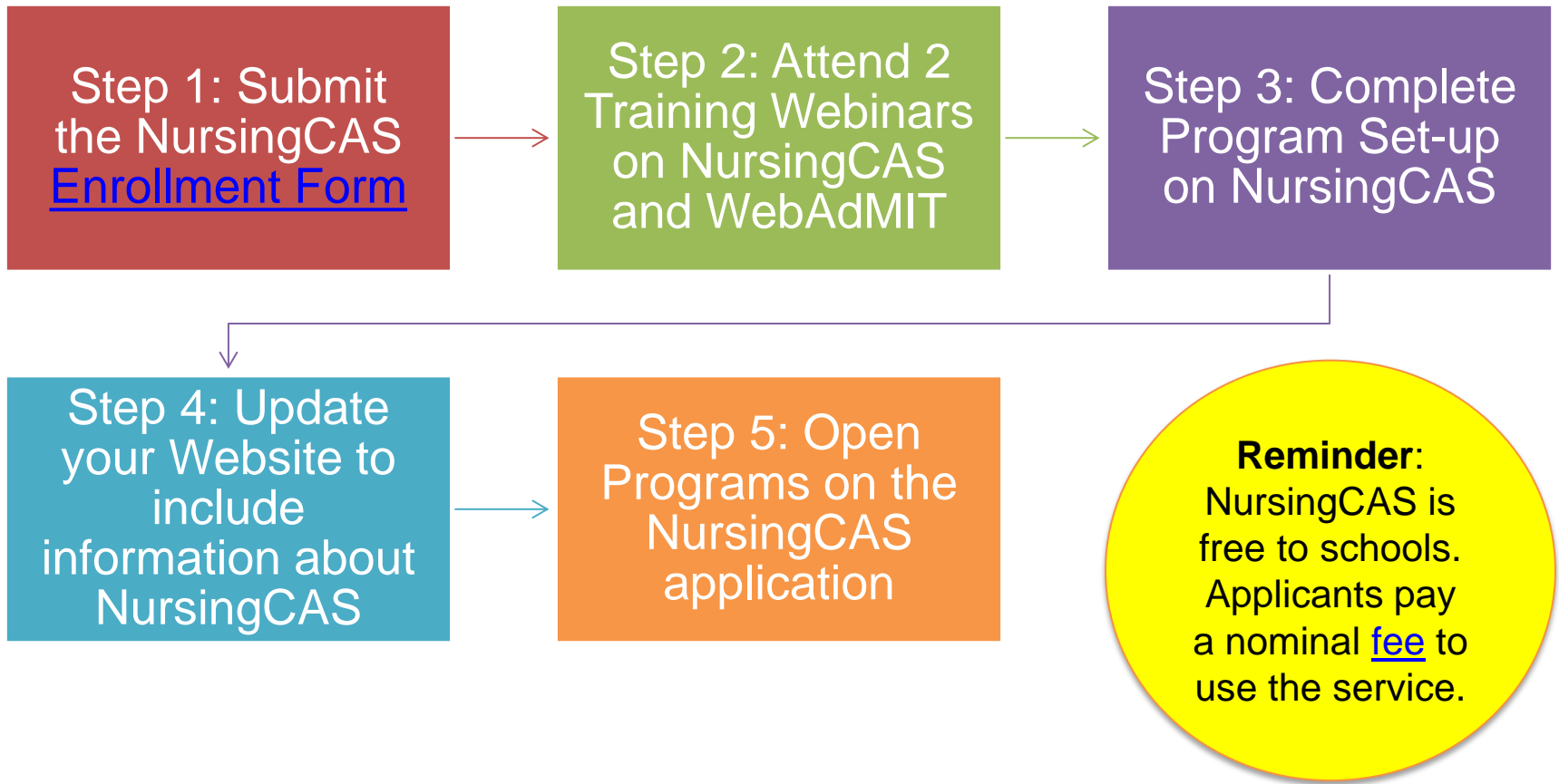

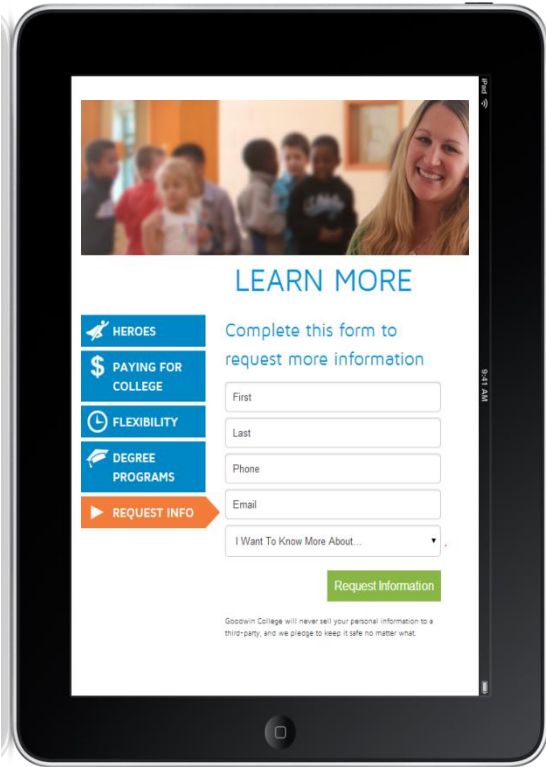

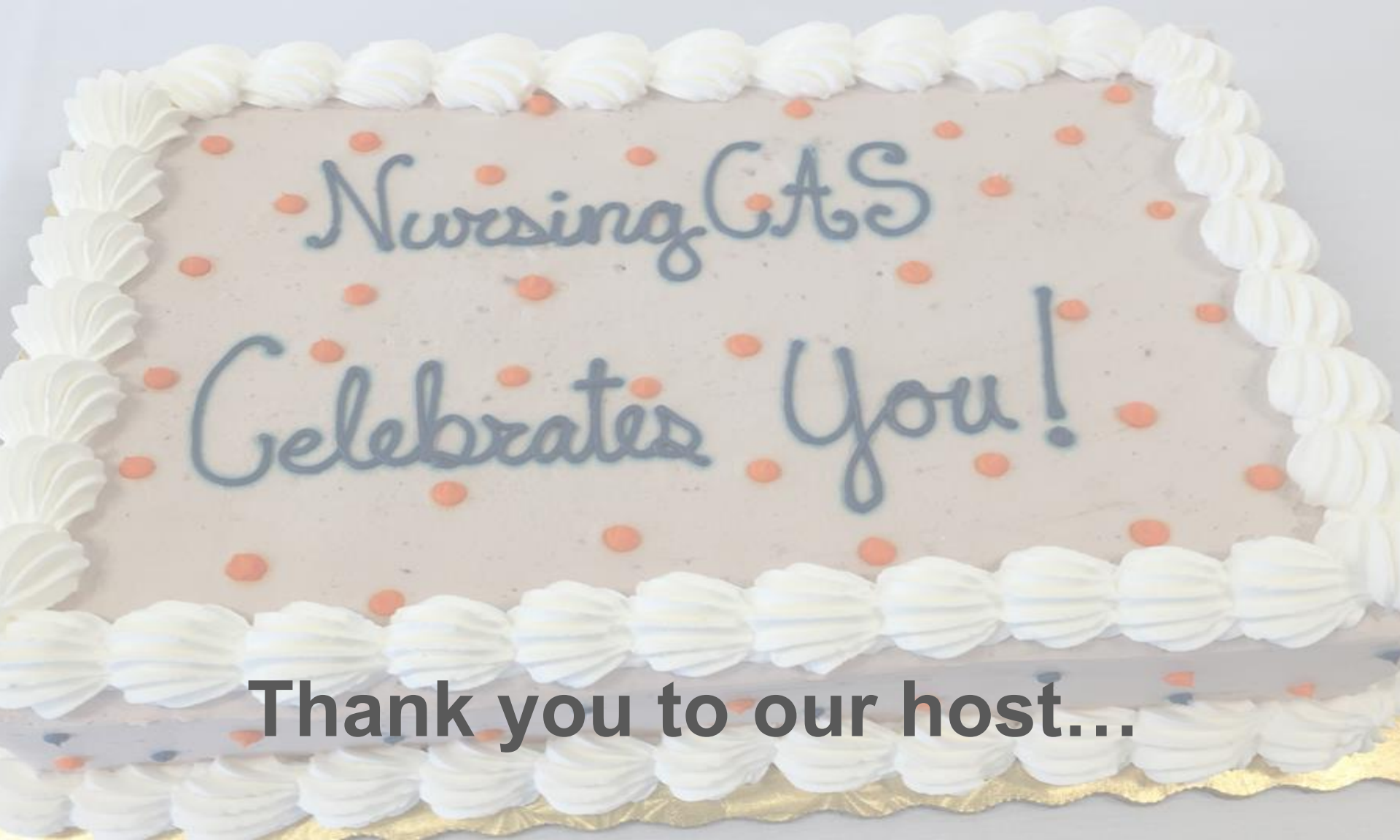
