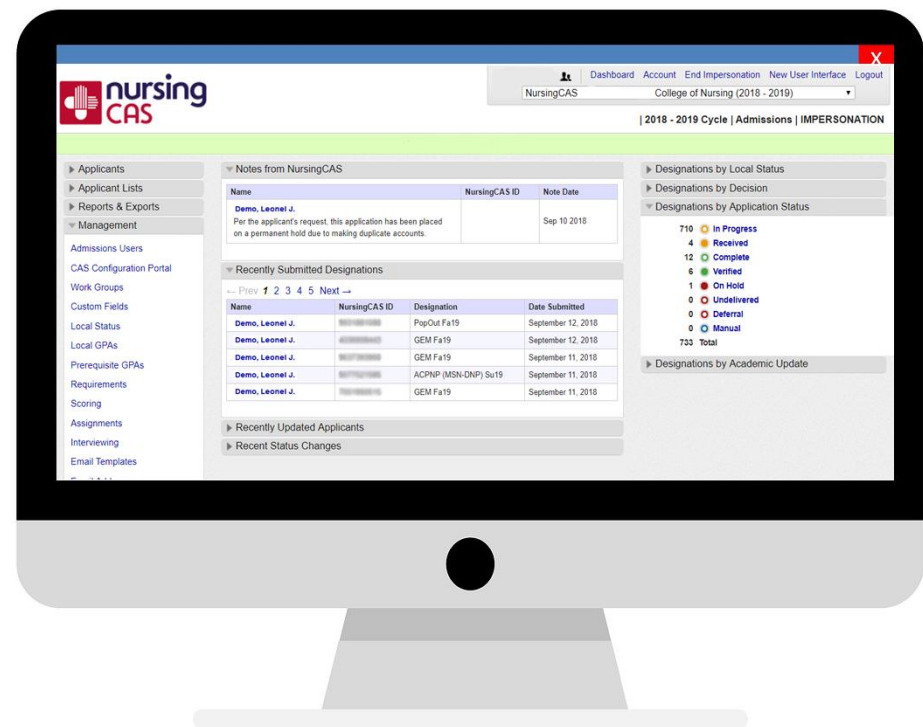

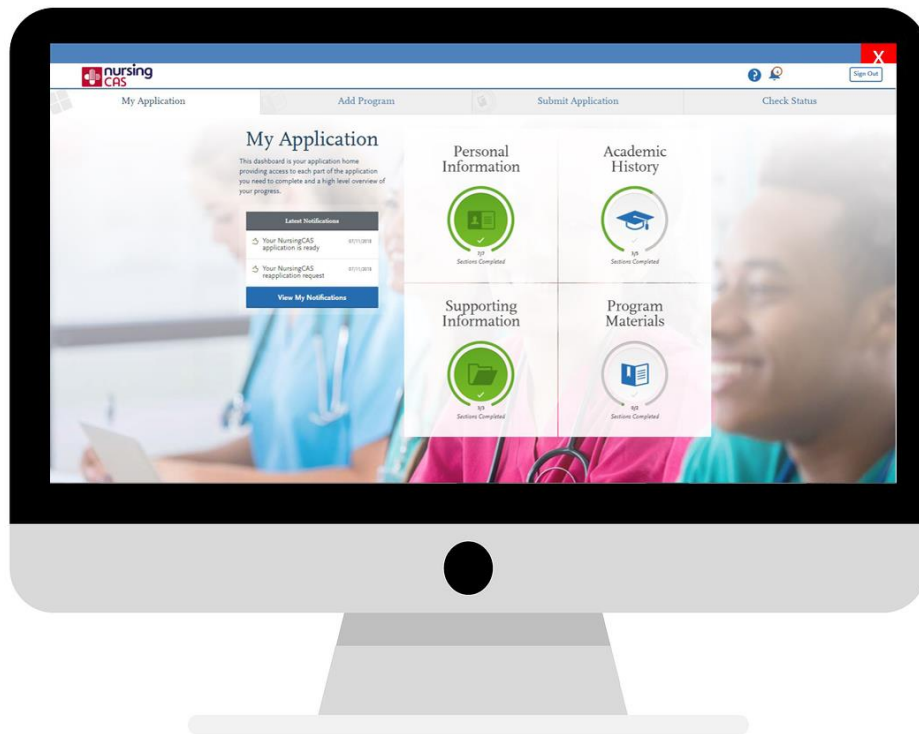
NURSINGCAS IS A FREE CUSTOMIZABLE TOOL FOR YOUR SCHOOL TO USE TO COLLECT AND REVIEW ADMISSIONS INFORMATION FROM APPLICANTS

- Utilize the custom questions, document upload, and reference features to collect essays and key criteria needed for admissions review
- Conduct an admission review online – utilize the tools in WebAdMIT such as assignments and scoring features



Applicants can easily apply to any participating nursing program at 270+ schools:

Master of Science in Nursing (for students with a Bachelor's degree in Nursing)

NOTE: If you are a USF College of Nursing graduate who earned the BS in Nursing and has NOT taken coursework since then, please do not apply through this application. Please return to the Search fields and select "USF Alumni Master of Science (Nursing) All Concentrations" and apply there.

A Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) is a registered nurse with a graduate degree in nursing that is prepared for advanced practice with individuals and families throughout the lifespan and across the health continuum. This practice includes independent and interdependent decision-making and direct accountability for clinical judgment. Graduate preparation expands the comprehensiveness of the FNP role to include participation in and use of research development and implementation of health policy, leadership, education, case management and consultation.

Prior to completing the NursingCAS application, please complete the USF Graduate Admissions application [here](#). Both applications must be submitted to be eligible for review.

Applications are reviewed as they are received and Verified through NursingCAS. The verification process may take several days, and begins upon submitting a complete application with all required items. We are on rolling admission through March 15th. Admission decisions may be issued as early as February 15th.

Applicants will be evaluated on:

- Bachelor's degree in nursing from a regionally accredited program
- Resume
- Earned grade point average of 3.00 or higher on 4.00 scale in all work attempted while registered as an upper division applicant working on a baccalaureate nursing degree
- Three professional recommendations
- Current unencumbered license as a registered nurse in the United States upon matriculation. Current license as a registered nurse in the state of Florida before the first clinical course.
- Interviews may be required, on an invitation basis.

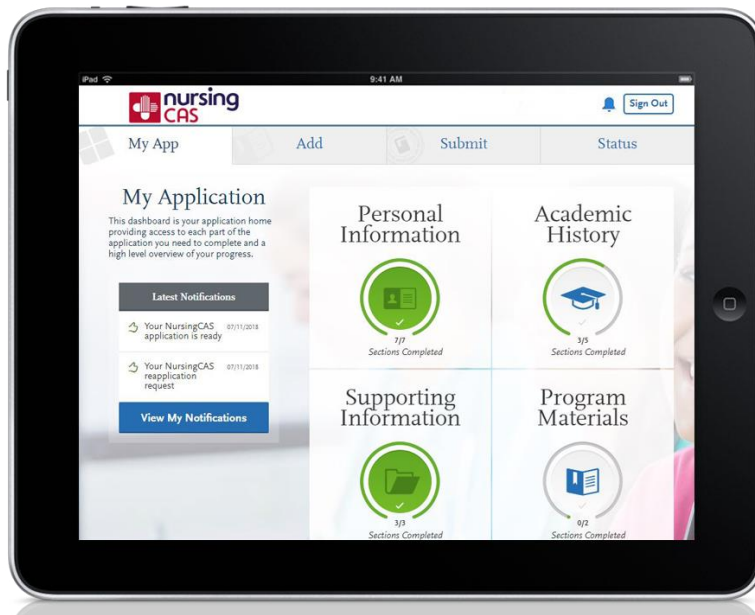

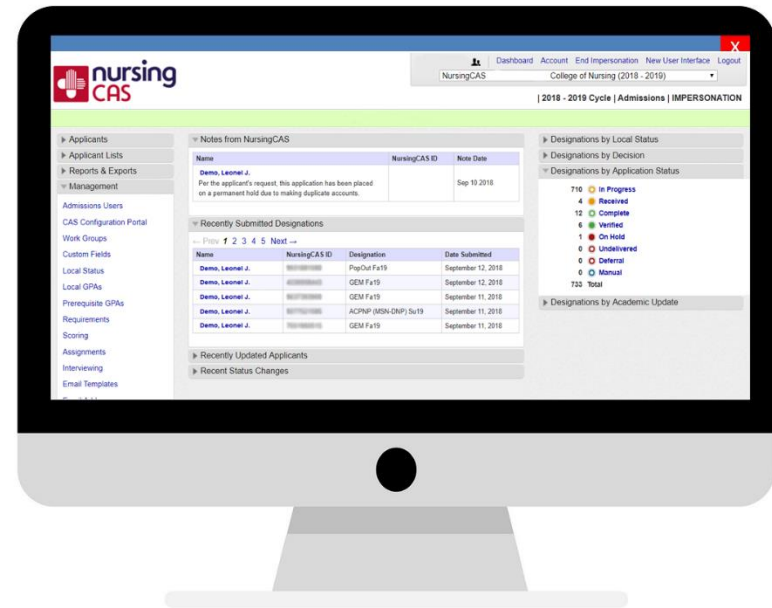
Live Demo of How NursingCAS Works
